### **Automated decision making**

Mountain does not make decisions based on automated processing on matters that (significant) consequences for people. These are decisions taken by computer programs or systems, without human involvement.

### **How long we keep personal data**

Mountain does not store your company and personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to maintain and achieve the purposes for which your data is collected.

### **Sharing personal data with third parties**

Mountain does not sell your information to third parties and only provides it if necessary is for the performance of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. We conclude a processor agreement contract with companies that process your data on our behalf to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Mountain remains responsible for these processing operations.

### **Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use**

Mountain only uses technical and functional cookies. And analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is saved on your first visit to this website and is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone. The cookies that we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and remembers for example your preferences. We can also use this to optimize our website. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that they do not stores more cookies. In addition, you can also view all information previously saved via the delete settings from your browser.

## **View, modify or delete data**

You have the right to view, correct or delete your company and personal data. In addition, you have the right to request your consent for the withdraw of the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Mountain and you have the right to data portability. That means that you can submit a request to us for the personal data we hold about you in a computer file sent to you or another organization named by you to steer.

You can request access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request to withdraw your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to [info@mountain.nl](mailto:info@mountain.nl). To be sure that the request for inspection has been made by you, we ask you for a copy of your proof of identity send with the request. Make in this copy your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and citizen service number (BSN) black. This is to protect your privacy. We will respond as soon as possible, but within four weeks, at your request.

Mountain would also like to point out that you have the opportunity to submit a complaint to the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
